

1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Lottery Law is amended by changing  
5 Section 2 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 1605/2) (from Ch. 120, par. 1152)

7 Sec. 2. This Act is enacted to implement and establish  
8 within the State a lottery to be conducted by the State through  
9 the Department. The entire net proceeds of the Lottery are to  
10 be used for the support of the State's Common School Fund,  
11 except as provided in subsection (o) of Section 9.1 and  
12 Sections 21.5, 21.6, 21.7, 21.8, and 21.9. The General Assembly  
13 finds that it is in the public interest for the Department to  
14 conduct the functions of the Lottery with the assistance of a  
15 private manager under a management agreement overseen by the  
16 Department. The Department shall be accountable to the General  
17 Assembly and the people of the State through a comprehensive  
18 system of regulation, audits, reports, and enduring  
19 operational oversight. The Department's ongoing conduct of the  
20 Lottery through a management agreement with a private manager  
21 shall act to promote and ensure the integrity, security,  
22 honesty, and fairness of the Lottery's operation and  
23 administration. It is the intent of the General Assembly that

1 the Department shall conduct the Lottery with the assistance of  
2 a private manager under a management agreement at all times in  
3 a manner consistent with 18 U.S.C. 1307(a)(1), 1307(b)(1),  
4 1953(b)(4).

5 Beginning with Fiscal Year 2018 and every year thereafter,  
6 any moneys transferred from the State Lottery Fund to the  
7 Common School Fund shall be supplemental to, and not in lieu  
8 of, any other money due to be transferred to the Common School  
9 Fund by law or appropriation.
