Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by changing Section 45-15 as follows:

- Sec. 45-15. Soybean oil-based ink <u>and vegetable oil-based</u>

 8 ink.
- 9 (a) As used in this Section:
- 10 "Digital printing" means a printing method which includes,
- 11 but is not limited to, the electrostatic process of
- 12 transferring ink or toner to a substrate. This process may
- involve the use of photo imaging plates, photoreceptor drums,
- or belts which hold an electrostatic charge. "Digital printing"
- is also defined as a process of transferring ink through a
- print head directly to a substrate, as is done with ink-jet
- 17 <u>printers.</u>
- "Offset printing" means lithography, flexography, gravure,
- or letterpress. "Offset printing" involves the process of
- 20 transferring ink through static or fixed image plates using an
- 21 <u>impact method of pressing ink into a substrate.</u>
- 22 <u>(b)</u> Contracts requiring the procurement of <u>offset</u> printing
- 23 services shall specify the use of soybean oil-based ink or

- vegetable oil-based ink unless a State purchasing officer 1
- 2 determines that another type of ink is required to assure high
- 3 quality and reasonable pricing of the printed product.
- This Section does not apply to digital printing services. 4
