 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 244, AS AMENDED, by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following:

 "Section 5. The Cannabis Control Act is amended by changing Section 5.2 as follows:
- 7 (720 ILCS 550/5.2) (from Ch. 56 1/2, par. 705.2)
- 8 Sec. 5.2. Delivery of cannabis on school grounds.
- (a) Any person, other than an enrolled student, who 9 violates subsection (e) of Section 5 in any school, on the real 10 property comprising any school, or any conveyance owned, leased 11 12 or contracted by a school to transport students to or from school or a school related activity, or on any public way 13 within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising any school, 14 15 or any conveyance owned, leased or contracted by a school to transport students to or from school or a school related 16

- 1 activity, is quilty of a Class 1 felony, the fine for which shall not exceed \$200,000; 2
- (b) Any person, other than an enrolled student, violates subsection (d) of Section 5 in any school, on the real property comprising any school, or any conveyance owned, leased 6 or contracted by a school to transport students to or from school or a school related activity, or on any public way 7 within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising any school, or any conveyance owned, leased or contracted by a school to transport students to or from school or a school related activity, is guilty of a Class 2 felony, the fine for which shall not exceed \$100,000;
 - (c) Any person, other than an enrolled student, violates subsection (c) of Section 5 in any school, on the real property comprising any school, or any conveyance owned, leased or contracted by a school to transport students to or from school or a school related activity, or on any public way within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising any school, or any conveyance owned, leased or contracted by a school to transport students to or from school or a school related activity, is guilty of a Class 3 felony, the fine for which shall not exceed \$50,000;
 - (d) Any person, other than an enrolled student, violates subsection (b) of Section 5 in any school, on the real property comprising any school, or any conveyance owned, leased or contracted by a school to transport students to or from

1 school or a school related activity, or on any public way within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising any school, 2 3 or any conveyance owned, leased or contracted by a school to 4 transport students to or from school or a school related 5 activity, is quilty of a Class 4 felony, the fine for which shall not exceed \$25,000; 6

(e) Any person, other than an enrolled student, who violates subsection (a) of Section 5 in any school, on the real property comprising any school, or any conveyance owned, leased or contracted by a school to transport students to or from school or a school related activity, on any public way within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising any school, or any conveyance owned, leased or contracted by a school to transport students to or from school or a school related activity, is quilty of a Class A misdemeanor.

(f) As used in this Section:

"Charter school" has the meaning ascribed to the term in Section 27A-5 of the School Code.

"Enrolled student" means a student registered at an active and operational public, private, charter, or parochial elementary or secondary school, community college, college, or university.

"School" means an active and operational public, private, charter, or parochial elementary or secondary school, community college, college, or university and includes the grounds of an active and operational school,
