Amends the State Commemorative Dates Act. Provides that August 26th of each year is designated as Illinois Constitution Day, to be observed throughout the State as a day to commemorate August 26, 1818 as the day Illinois ratified its first State Constitution.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by
5 adding Section 195 as follows:

7 Sec. 195. Illinois Constitution Day. August 26th of each
8 year is designated as Illinois Constitution Day, to be observed
9 throughout the State as a day to commemorate August 26, 1818 as
10 the day Illinois ratified its first State Constitution.
