## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Park District Code is amended by adding
- 5 Section 8-23a as follows:
- 6 (70 ILCS 1205/8-23a new)
- Sec. 8-23a. Application for volunteers; disclosure of
- 8 <u>child sex offenses; penalty for failure to disclose.</u>
- 9 (a) For purposes of this Section:
- 10 "Child sex offender" has the meaning provided in paragraph
- 11 (1) of subsection (d) of Section 11-9.3 of the Criminal Code of
- 2012.
- "Volunteer" means any individual who without compensation
- or benefits reports to, and is under the direct supervision of,
- 15 <u>a park district's administrative staff and provides personal</u>
- 16 services to a park district recreational program that is
- offered to children.
- 18 (b) Every park district shall require volunteers to
- 19 complete an application prior to beginning any work as a
- 20 volunteer. The application shall include, but shall not be
- 21 limited to, a question for the applicant to answer concerning
- 22 whether they have been convicted of or found to be a child sex
- offender. If a volunteer is under 18 years of age, the

- 1 volunteer's parent or legal guardian may complete the
- application on behalf of the volunteer. No park district shall 2
- 3 knowingly engage a volunteer who has been convicted of or found
- 4 to be a child sex offender and shall terminate the services of
- 5 the volunteer upon discovery of such an offender.
- (c) If a current volunteer with a park district is 6
- convicted of or found to be a child sex offender, the volunteer 7
- shall immediately disclose the conviction or finding to the 8
- 9 park district.
