Amends the Massage Licensing Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning title protection.

AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Massage Licensing Act is amended by changing
Section 30 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 57/30)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2022)

8 Sec. 30. Title protection.

9 (a) Persons regulated by this Act are designated as massage 10 therapists <u>and</u> and therefore are exclusively entitled to 11 utilize the terms "massage", "massage therapy", and "massage 12 therapist" when advertising or printing promotional material.

(b) Anyone who knowingly aids and abets one or more persons not authorized to use a professional title regulated by this Act or knowingly employs persons not authorized to use the regulated professional title in the course of their employment, commits a violation of this Act.

18 (c) Anyone not authorized, under the definitions of this 19 Act, to utilize the term "massage", "massage therapy", or 20 "massage therapist" and who knowingly utilizes these terms when 21 advertising commits a violation of this Act.

(d) Nothing in this Act shall prohibit the use of the terms
"massage", "massage therapy", or "massage therapist" by a salon
