1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1798

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 1798, by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting the
4 following:

5 "Section 1. The appropriations contained in this Act are
6 intended for the purpose of continuing the existing process of
7 administering payments that were previously authorized pursuant
8 to the order of the Circuit Court of the 20th Judicial Circuit
9 in St. Clair County (Case # 15-CH-475). The appropriations
10 contained in this Act are intended to provide for the
11 unobligated amounts for payments remaining for fiscal year
12 2017.

13 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof as
14 is necessary, respectively, which may be sub-allocated

1 according to coding, pursuant to the Comptroller, are
2 appropriated to the following agencies from the General Revenue
3 Fund for the purpose of making personnel-related payments for
4 employees of the State, including but not limited to personal
5 services, contractual payrolls, social security and Medicare
6 contributions, retirement contributions, and group health
7 insurance contributions:

3 is necessary, respectively, which may be sub-allocated
4 according to coding, pursuant to the Comptroller, is
5 appropriated to the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy
6 from the Education Assistance Fund for the purpose of making
7 personnel-related payments for employees of the State,
8 including but not limited to personal services, contractual
9 payrolls, social security and Medicare contributions,
10 retirement contributions, and group health insurance
11 contributions.

12 Section 15. The following named sums, or so much thereof
13 as is necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the
14 Education Assistance Fund for payroll related deductions
15 pursuant to the Illinois Comptroller's payroll offsets

23 Section 30. The sum of \$280,000,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Human
2 Services for grants associated with Child Care Services,
3 including operating and administrative costs.

4 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
5 becoming law.".
