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1	AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1858
2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 1858, AS AMENDED, by
3	replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
4	following:
5	"Section 5. The Legislative Commission Reorganization Act
6	of 1984 is amended by changing Section 8A-35 and by adding
7	Section 8A-60 as follows:
8	(25 ILCS 130/8A-35)
9	Sec. 8A-35. Capitol Restoration Trust Fund;
10	appropriations.
11	(a) The Capitol Restoration Trust Fund is created as a
12	special fund within the State treasury. The Fund may accept
13	deposits from any source, whether private or public, and may be
14	appropriated only for the use of the Architect of the Capitol
15	in the performance of his or her powers and duties. The
16	Architect of the Capitol may seek private and public funds for

1	deposit into the Capitol Restoration Trust Fund.
2	(a-5) The Capitol Restoration Trust Fund shall contain a
3	separate account for the deposit of funds donated for the
4	payment of expenses associated with the placement of a
5	Presidential Statue at the State Capitol Building depicting
6	President Ronald W. Reagan, as provided under Section 8A-60.
7	The separate account may accept deposits from any source,
8	whether private or public, and may be appropriated only for use
9	by the Architect of the Capitol for expenses associated with
10	the acquisition, placement, and maintenance of the
11	Presidential Statue authorized under subsection (a) of Section
12	8A-60. The Architect of the Capitol may seek private and public
13	funds for deposit into the separate account of the Capitol
14	Restoration Trust Fund established under this subsection
15	<u>(a-5).</u>
16	(a-10) The Capitol Restoration Trust Fund shall contain a
17	separate account for the deposit of funds donated for the
18	payment of expenses associated with the placement of a
19	Presidential Statue at the State Capitol Building depicting
20	President Barack H. Obama, as provided under Section 8A-60. The
21	separate account may accept deposits from any source, whether
22	private or public, and may be appropriated only for use by the
23	Architect of the Capitol for expenses associated with the
24	acquisition, placement, and maintenance of the Presidential
25	Statue authorized under subsection (b) of Section 8A-60. The
26	Architect of the Capitol may seek private and public funds for

1 deposit into the separate account of the Capitol Restoration 2 Trust Fund established under this subsection (a-10). 3 (a-15) The Capitol Restoration Trust Fund shall contain a 4 separate account for the deposit of funds donated for the 5 payment of expenses associated with the placement of a statue 6 at the State Capitol Building depicting Governor James R. 7 Thompson, as provided under Section 8A-60. The separate account may accept deposits from any source, whether private or public, 8 9 and may be appropriated only for use by the Architect of the 10 Capitol for expenses associated with the acquisition, 11 placement, and maintenance of the statue authorized under subsection (c) of Section 8A-60. The Architect of the Capitol 12 13 may seek private and public funds for deposit into the separate 14 account of the Capitol Restoration Trust Fund established under 15 this subsection (a-15). 16 (a-20) The Capitol Restoration Trust Fund shall contain a separate account for the deposit of funds donated for the 17 18 payment of expenses associated with the placement of a statue 19 at the State Capitol Building depicting State Representative 20 and Illinois labor union leader Reuben G. Soderstrom, as provided under Section 8A-60. The separate account may accept 21 22 deposits from any source, whether private or public, and may be 23 appropriated only for use by the Architect of the Capitol for 24 expenses associated with the acquisition, placement, and maintenance of the statue authorized under subsection (d) of 25 26 Section 8A-60. The Architect of the Capitol may seek private

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1 and public funds for deposit into the separate account of the Capitol Restoration Trust Fund established under this 2 3 subsection (a-20). 4 (a-25) The Capitol Restoration Trust Fund shall contain a 5 separate account for the deposit of funds donated for the 6 payment of expenses associated with the placement of a statue 7 at the State Capitol Building depicting Mayor of Chicago Harold Washington, as provided under Section 8A-60. The separate 8 9 account may accept deposits from any source, whether private or 10 public, and may be appropriated only for use by the Architect 11 of the Capitol for expenses associated with the acquisition, placement, and maintenance of the statue authorized under 12 13 subsection (e) of Section 8A-60. The Architect of the Capitol 14 may seek private and public funds for deposit into the separate 15 account of the Capitol Restoration Trust Fund established under this subsection (a-25). 16 (a-30) The Capitol Restoration Trust Fund shall contain a 17 separate account for the deposit of funds donated for the 18 19 payment of expenses associated with the placement of a statue at the State Capitol Building depicting Jean Baptiste Point du 20 Sable, as provided under Section 8A-60. The separate account 21 22 may accept deposits from any source, whether private or public, 23 and may be appropriated only for use by the Architect of the 24 Capitol for expenses associated with the acquisition, 25 placement, and maintenance of the statue authorized under subsection (f) of Section 8A-60. The Architect of the Capitol 26

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1 <u>may seek private and public funds for deposit into the separate</u> 2 <u>account of the Capitol Restoration Trust Fund established under</u> 3 <u>this subsection (a-30).</u>

4 (b) The Architect of the Capitol shall submit all budget 5 requests to implement the master plan that relate to areas of 6 the legislative complex other than the State Capitol Building 7 to the Capitol Historic Preservation Board for review and 8 comment. The Architect of the Capitol shall submit all budget 9 requests to the Board of the Office of the Architect of the 10 Capitol for approval.

13 <u>Sec. 8A-60. State Capitol statues.</u>

14 (a) The Architect of the Capitol, at the direction of the 15 Board of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, shall provide for the acquisition and placement of a statue at the 16 State Capitol Building depicting 40th President of the United 17 States Ronald W. Reagan. The Architect of the Capitol may 18 19 provide for the design and fabrication of the statue, or may otherwise acquire, using funds collected for such purpose or a 20 21 statue donated to the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, a 22 suitable statue for placement under this Section.

(b) The Architect of the Capitol, at the direction of the
Board of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, shall
provide for the acquisition and placement of a statue at the

State Capitol Building depicting 44th President of the United States Barack H. Obama. The Architect of the Capitol may provide for the design and fabrication of the statue, or may otherwise acquire, using funds collected for such purpose or a statue donated to the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, a suitable statue for placement under this Section.

(c) The Architect of the Capitol, at the direction of the 7 Board of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, shall 8 9 provide for the acquisition and placement of a statue at the 10 State Capitol Building depicting 37th Governor of the State of Illinois James R. Thompson. The Architect of the Capitol may 11 12 provide for the design and fabrication of the statue, or may 13 otherwise acquire, using funds collected for such purpose or a 14 statue donated to the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, a 15 suitable statue for placement under this Section.

16 (d) The Architect of the Capitol, at the direction of the Board of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, shall 17 provide for the acquisition and placement of a statue at the 18 19 State Capitol Building depicting State Representative and Illinois labor union leader Reuben G. Soderstrom. The Architect 20 21 of the Capitol may provide for the design and fabrication of 22 the statue, or may otherwise acquire, using funds collected for 23 such purpose or a statue donated to the Office of the Architect 24 of the Capitol, a suitable statue for placement under this 25 Section.

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(e) The Architect of the Capitol, at the direction of the

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1 Board of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, shall provide for the acquisition and placement of a statue at the 2 State Capitol Building depicting Mayor of Chicago Harold 3 4 Washington. The Architect of the Capitol may provide for the 5 design and fabrication of the statue, or may otherwise acquire, 6 using funds collected for such purpose or a statue donated to the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, a suitable statue 7 8 for placement under this Section. 9 (f) The Architect of the Capitol, at the direction of the 10 Board of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, shall 11 provide for the acquisition and placement of a statue at the 12 State Capitol Building depicting Jean Baptiste Point du Sable. 13 The Architect of the Capitol may provide for the design and 14 fabrication of the statue, or may otherwise acquire, using 15 funds collected for such purpose or a statue donated to the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, a suitable statue for 16 17 placement under this Section. (g) The Architect of the Capitol, at the direction of the 18 19 Board of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, shall take 20 actions necessary to provide for the placement and unveiling of 21 the Presidential Statues authorized under subsections (a) and (b) at the Capitol by February 15, 2021 (Presidents' Day). 22 23 Prior to the placement of the statues at the Capitol, the 24 Architect of the Capitol shall issue a report detailing his or 25 her actions in acquiring and placing the statues specified under this subsection (f). The report shall be delivered to the 26

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<u>Governor and the General Assembly on or before December 1,</u>
<u>2020. The report to the General Assembly shall be filed with</u>
<u>the Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of</u>
<u>the Senate in electronic form only, in the manner that the</u>
<u>Clerk and the Secretary shall direct.</u>

(h) The Architect of the Capitol, at the direction of the 6 Board of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, shall take 7 8 actions necessary to provide for the placement and unveiling of 9 the statues authorized under subsections (c), (d), (e), and (f) 10 within a reasonable period of time after the effective date of 11 this amendatory Act of the 100th General Assembly, except that, 12 notwithstanding the requirements of subsection (g), the statue 13 depicting Reuben G. Soderstrom shall be placed on Capitol 14 grounds before any other statue authorized under this Section. 15 Prior to the placement of the statues at the Capitol, the 16 Architect of the Capitol shall issue a report detailing his or her actions in acquiring and placing the statues specified 17 under this subsection (h). The report shall be delivered to the 18 Governor and the General Assembly. The report to the General 19 20 Assembly shall be filed with the Clerk of the House of 21 Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate in electronic 22 form only, in the manner that the Clerk and the Secretary shall 23 direct.

24 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 25 becoming law.".
