8 <u>(a)</u> Before the acceptance of a plea of guilty, guilty but 9 mentally ill, or nolo contendere to a misdemeanor or felony 10 offense, the court shall give the following advisement to the 11 defendant in open court:

"If you are not a citizen of the United States, you are hereby advised that conviction of the offense for which you have been charged may have the <u>consequence</u> consequences of deportation, exclusion from admission to the United States, or denial of naturalization under the laws of the United States.".
