#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

725 ILCS 5/110-14

from Ch. 38, par. 110-14

Amends the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963. Provides that any person incarcerated on a bailable offense who does not supply bail and against whom a fine is levied on conviction of such offense shall be allowed a credit of \$30 (rather than \$5) for each day so incarcerated upon application of the defendant.

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is  
5 amended by changing Section 110-14 as follows:

6 (725 ILCS 5/110-14) (from Ch. 38, par. 110-14)

7 Sec. 110-14. Credit for Incarceration on Bailable Offense.

8 (a) Any person incarcerated on a bailable offense who does  
9 not supply bail and against whom a fine is levied on conviction  
10 of such offense shall be allowed a credit of \$30 ~~\$5~~ for each  
11 day so incarcerated upon application of the defendant. However,  
12 in no case shall the amount so allowed or credited exceed the  
13 amount of the fine.

14 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a person incarcerated  
15 for sexual assault as defined in paragraph (1) of subsection  
16 (a) of Section 5-9-1.7 of the Unified Code of Corrections.
