#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 801/21 new  
20 ILCS 835/4d new  
20 ILCS 3405/36 new

Amends the Department of Natural Resources Act. Provides that only materials manufactured in Illinois may be sold on the property of the Illinois State Museum. Defines "materials manufactured in Illinois". Amends the State Parks Act. Provides that only materials manufactured in Illinois may be sold in gift shops or concession areas within State parks or parkways. Defines "materials manufactured in Illinois". Amends the Historic Preservation Agency Act. Provides that only materials manufactured in Illinois may be sold on the property of State Historic Sites, State Memorials, and the other properties over which the Historic Preservation Agency has jurisdiction. Defines "materials manufactured in Illinois".

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Department of Natural Resources Act is  
5 amended by adding Section 21 and 4d as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 801/21 new)

7 Sec. 21. Prohibitions. Only materials manufactured in  
8 Illinois may be sold on the property of the Illinois State  
9 Museum. As used in this Section, "materials manufactured in  
10 Illinois" means assembled articles, materials, or supplies for  
11 which design, final assembly, processing, packaging, testing,  
12 or other process that adds value, quality, or reliability  
13 occurred in Illinois.

14 Section 10. The State Parks Act is amended by adding  
15 Section 4d as follows:

16 (20 ILCS 835/4d new)

17 Sec. 4d. Prohibited sales. Only materials manufactured in  
18 Illinois may be sold in gift shops or concession areas within  
19 State parks or parkways. As used in this Section, "materials  
20 manufactured in Illinois" means assembled articles, materials,  
21 or supplies for which design, final assembly, processing,

1 packaging, testing, or other process that adds value, quality,  
2 or reliability occurred in Illinois.

3 Section 15. The Historic Preservation Agency Act is amended  
4 by adding Section 36 as follows:

5 (20 ILCS 3405/36 new)

6 Sec. 36. Prohibitions. Only materials manufactured in  
7 Illinois may be sold on the property of State Historic Sites,  
8 State Memorials, and the other properties over which the  
9 Historic Preservation Agency has jurisdiction under Section 6  
10 of this Act. As used in this Section, "materials manufactured  
11 in Illinois" means assembled articles, materials, or supplies  
12 for which design, final assembly, processing, packaging,  
13 testing, or other process that adds value, quality, or  
14 reliability occurred in Illinois.
