2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2774, AS AMENDED,
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.
4 2 as follows:

5 on page 9, line 18, after the period, by inserting "Nothing in
6 this Section shall prevent a person from seeking a right of
7 action for a violation of the Biometric Information Privacy Act
8 or otherwise seeking relief under the Code of Civil Procedure.

9 on page 10, by replacing lines 13 through 16 with the
10 following:

11 "(d) Nothing in this Act shall be construed to apply to any
12 State agency, federal agency, unit of local government, or any
13 contractor, subcontractor, or agent thereof, when working for
14 that State agency, federal agency, or unit of local government.

15 (e) Nothing in this Act shall be construed to apply to any

1 entity recognized as a tax-exempt organization under 501(c) (3)
2 and 501(c) (4) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.".
