1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2828

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2828 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Park and Recreational Facility
5 Construction Act of 2009 is amended by changing Section 10-20
6 as follows:

7 (30 ILCS 764/10-20)

8 Sec. 10-20. Priorities for projects. In considering
9 applications for grants under this Act, the Department shall
10 give priority to projects that will provide the greatest
11 benefit to the residents of the State, based upon criteria
12 established by the Department in rules promulgated pursuant to
13 this Act which reflect the useful life of existing facilities
14 and improvements, address public health and safety needs,
15 correct accessibility deficiencies, and reflect outdoor
16 recreation needs and priorities, including handicap-accessible

1 playground equipment, such as ramped, ground-level play
2 features, accessible swings, wheelchair accessible tables,
3 adjustable equipment, universally accessible swings, and
4 transfer platforms, identified through the Department's
5 Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (SCORP)
6 Program. The Department shall prioritize projects that create
7 parks universally designed to meet everyone's needs, ages, and
8 mobility and where all equipment, and the park itself, is
9 handicap-accessible over projects that would create parks
10 where only some equipment, or only the park itself, is
11 handicap-accessible.
