12	(b) The Department of	Public Health may require any
13	facility licensed by the Dep	artment to implement an influenza
14	vaccination program that en	sures that the employees of the
15	facility are offered the opp	ortunity to be vaccinated against

seasonal influenza and any other novel or pandemic influenza

- viruses as vaccines become available. The Department may adopt 1
- rules setting forth the requirements of the influenza 2
- 3 vaccination program. A health care employee may decline the
- 4 offer of vaccination if the vaccine is medically
- 5 contraindicated, if the vaccination is against the employee's
- religious beliefs, or if the employee has already been 6
- vaccinated. General philosophical or moral reluctance to 7
- influenza vaccinations does not provide a sufficient basis for 8
- 9 an exemption.
