### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

705 ILCS 35/28.5 new

Amends the Circuit Courts Act. Provides that every circuit court judge shall announce that a person can file a complaint against him or her, prior to calling the first case of the day, and that a person can pick up a form with instructions on filing a complaint from the clerk. Provides that the clerk of the circuit court shall make available instructions for the filing of a complaint against a judge with the Judicial Inquiry Board. Provides that the clerk shall post within each courtroom a notice that a person may file a complaint against the judge and that instructions for filing a complaint may be obtained from the clerk.

4 Section 5. The Circuit Courts Act is amended by adding  
5 Section 28.5 as follows:

7 Sec. 28.5. Complaints; instructions for filing.

8 (a) Every circuit court judge shall announce that a person  
9 can file a complaint against him or her, prior to calling the  
10 first case of the day, and that a person can pick up a form with  
11 instructions on filing a complaint from the clerk.

12 (b) The clerk of the circuit court shall make available  
13 instructions for the filing of a complaint against a judge with  
14 the Judicial Inquiry Board.

15 (c) The clerk shall post within each courtroom a notice  
16 that a person may file a complaint against the judge and that  
17 instructions for filing a complaint may be obtained from the  
18 clerk.
