1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3185

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 3185, AS AMENDED,  
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.  
4 1, as follows:

5 on page 3, line 23, by replacing "chairman" with "chairperson  
6 ~~chairman~~"; and

7 on page 6, by replacing lines 7 through 15 with the following:  
8 "conduct and grading of examinations. ~~Examinations may be~~  
9 ~~written, oral, by statement of training and experience, in the~~  
10 ~~form of tests of knowledge, skill, capacity, intellect,~~  
11 ~~aptitude; or, by any other method, which in the judgment of the~~  
12 ~~Merit Board is reasonable and practical for any particular~~  
13 ~~classification. Different examining procedures may be~~  
14 ~~determined for the examinations in different classifications~~  
15 ~~but all examinations in the same classification shall be~~  
16 ~~uniform.~~"; and

1 by replacing line 24 on page 8 through line 2 on page 9 with the  
2 following:

3 "(14) To authorize the creation and use of pilot  
4 programs to further the goals of this Act, which may be  
5 inconsistent with any rules adopted by the Merit Board,  
6 provided that such programs are of limited duration and do  
7 not reduce any rights or benefits of employees subject to  
8 this Act."; and

9 on page 11, line 6, after "positions", by inserting ", entry  
10 level only,"; and

11 by replacing line 26 on page 13 through line 3 on page 14 with  
12 the following:

13 "(g) Employees in positions covered by this Act who, while  
14 in good standing, leave to engage in military service during a  
15 period of hostility~~7~~ shall be given credit for seniority  
16 purposes for time served in the armed forces."
