SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

520 ILCS 5/2.28-5 new

Amends the Wildlife Code. Provides that the Department of Natural Resources shall, on an annual basis, establish one deer hunting weekend for persons with disabilities in a manner consistent with the provisions of the Code. Provides that the Department may adopt administrative rules to implement the provision. Defines "person with a disability."

1 AN ACT concerning wildlife.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by adding Section
- 5 2.28-5 as follows:
- 6 (520 ILCS 5/2.28-5 new)
- 7 Sec. 2.28-5. Hunting weekend for persons with
- 8 <u>disabilities</u>. The Department shall, on an annual basis,
- 9 establish one deer hunting weekend for persons with
- disabilities in a manner consistent with the provisions of this
- 11 <u>Code</u>. The Department may adopt administrative rules to
- implement the provisions of this Section. For the purpose of
- this Section, "person with a disability" means when that person
- 14 has a Type 1 or Type 4, Class 2 disability as defined in
- 15 <u>Section 4A of the Illinois Identification Card Act. For</u>
- purposes of this Section, an Illinois Person with a Disability
- 17 Identification Card issued under the Illinois Identification
- 18 Card Act indicating that the person named has a Type 1 or Type
- 19 4, Class 2 disability shall be adequate documentation of the
- 20 disability.
