## 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Department of Natural Resources
(Conservation) Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois
is amended by adding Section 805-45 as follows:

- 8 Sec. 805-45. Adopt-a-Trail Program.
- 9 <u>(a) The Department shall establish an "Adopt-a-Trail"</u> 10 program that will allow volunteer groups to assist in 11 <u>maintaining and enhancing trails on State owned land.</u>
- 12 (b) Subject to subsection (c) of this Section, volunteer 13 groups in the Adopt-a-Trail program may adopt any available 14 trail or trail segment and may choose any one or more of the
- 15 following volunteer activities:
- 16 <u>(1) spring cleanups;</u>
- 17 (2) accessibility projects;
- 18 (3) special events;
- 19 (4) trail maintenance, enhancement, or realignment;
- 20 (5) public information and assistance; or
- 21 (6) training.
- 22 <u>The Department shall designate and approve specific</u> 23 activities to be performed by a volunteer group in the

1 Adopt-a-Trail program which shall be executed with an approved 2 Adopt-a-Trail agreement. Volunteer services shall not include 3 work historically performed by Department employees, including services that result in a reduction of hours or compensation or 4 5 that may be performed by an employee on layoff; nor shall volunteer services be inconsistent with the terms of a 6 7 collective bargaining agreement. The Department may provide 8 for more than one volunteer group to adopt an eligible trail or 9 trail segment. 10 (c) If the Department operates other programs in the 11 vicinity of the trail that allows volunteers to participate in 12 the Department's Adopt-a-park program or other resource, the Department shall coordinate these programs to provide for 13 14 efficient and effective volunteer programs in the area. 15 (d) A volunteer group that wishes to participate in the 16 Adopt-a-Trail program shall submit an application to the Department on a form provided by the Department. Volunteer 17 18 groups shall agree to the following: 19 (1) volunteer groups participate in the program for at 20 least a 2-year period; 21 (2) volunteer groups shall consist of at least 6 people 22 who are 18 years of age or older, unless the volunteer 23 group is a school or scout organization, in which case the 24 volunteers may be under 18 years of age, but supervised by 25 someone over the age of 18; 26 (3) volunteer groups shall contribute a total of at

least 200 service hours over a 2-year period; 1 2 (4) volunteer groups shall only execute Adopt-a-Trail 3 projects and activities after a volunteer project agreement has been completed and approved by the 4 5 Department; and 6 (5) volunteer groups shall comply with all reasonable 7 requirements of the Department. Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 8
