### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/22-83 new  
110 ILCS 805/3-29.11 new

Amends the School Code. Provides that students in grades 11 and 12 of East St. Louis School District 189 may take courses at Southwestern Illinois College for dual credit at no cost to the student. Amends the Public Community College Act to make conforming changes.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section  
5 22-83 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/22-83 new)

7 Sec. 22-83. Southwestern Illinois College dual credit  
8 program. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary,  
9 students in grades 11 and 12 of East St. Louis School District  
10 189 may take courses at Southwestern Illinois College for dual  
11 credit at no cost to the student.

12 Section 10. The Public Community College Act is amended by  
13 adding Section 3-29.11 as follows:

14 (110 ILCS 805/3-29.11 new)

15 Sec. 3-29.11. Southwestern Illinois College dual credit  
16 program. Notwithstanding any provisions of this Act to the  
17 contrary, Southwestern Illinois College shall allow students  
18 in grades 11 and 12 of East St. Louis School District 189 to  
19 take classes at the College for dual credit at no cost to the  
20 student.
