## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing Section 4-2003 as follows:
- 6 (55 ILCS 5/4-2003) (from Ch. 34, par. 4-2003)
- 7 Sec. 4-2003. Assistants.
- (a) Except as provided in Section 4-2001, where assistant 8 9 State's Attorneys are required in any county, the number of such assistants shall be determined by the county board, and 10 the salaries of such assistants shall be fixed by the State's 11 Attorney subject to budgetary limitations established by the 12 county board and paid out of the county treasury in quarterly 13 14 annual installments, on the order of the county board on the treasurer of said county. Such assistant State's Attorneys are 15 16 to be named by the State's Attorney of the county, and when so appointed shall take the oath of office in the same manner as 17 State's Attorneys and shall be under the supervision of the 18 19 State's Attorney.
- 20 <u>(b) The State's Attorney may appoint qualified attorneys to</u>
  21 <u>assist as Special Assistant State's Attorneys when the public</u>
- 22 <u>interest so requires.</u>
