### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.60 new  
105 ILCS 5/34-18.53 new

Amends the School Code. Requires school districts to develop and adopt a trauma response protocol by the 2018-2019 school year. Requires the trauma response protocol to include long-term responses to a traumatic incident, long-term care and counseling, and community engagement. Allows school districts to partner with local community providers in establishing and implementing the protocol.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections  
5 10-20.60 and 34-18.53 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.60 new)

7 Sec. 10-20.60. Trauma response protocol.

8 (a) School districts shall, by the 2018-2019 school year,  
9 develop and adopt a trauma response protocol to establish how  
10 the school district responds to traumatic incidents. The trauma  
11 response protocol shall include a long-term response to a  
12 traumatic incident, long-term care and counseling, and  
13 community engagement.

14 (b) School districts may partner with local community  
15 providers of these services in establishing and implementing  
16 the trauma response protocol.

19 (a) The board shall, by the 2018-2019 school year, develop  
20 and adopt a trauma response protocol to establish how the

2 community engagement.

3 (b) The board may partner with local community providers of
