1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3882

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 3882 on page 6, line
3 16, by inserting after the period the following:

4 "If the defendant has been charged with an offense involving
5 the use, possession, or discharge of a firearm, the court may
6 not deviate from a mandatory minimum sentence requirement,
7 unless it is the recommendation of a presentence investigation
8 and there is clear articulable evidence that the defendant is
9 not a threat to the public safety. This must be fully stated by
10 the court into the record at the time of sentencing."
