1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
7 hereinafter named, are appropriated from the Insurance Producer
8 Administration Fund to the Department of Insurance:

 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Insurance Producer
 5 Administration Fund to the Department of Insurance for costs
 6 and expenses related to or in support of Get Covered Illinois.

7 Section 15. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may
 8 be necessary, is appropriated from the Insurance Producer
 9 Administration Fund to the Department of Insurance for costs
 10 and expenses related to or in support of the agency's
 11 operations.

12 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
 13 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
 14 hereinafter named, are appropriated from the Insurance
 15 Financial Regulation Fund to the Department of Insurance:

10 Section 25. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as may
 11 be necessary, is appropriated from the Insurance Financial
 12 Regulation Fund to the Department of Insurance for costs and
 13 expenses related to or in support of the agency's operations.

14 Section 30. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may
 15 be necessary, is appropriated from the George Bailey Memorial
 16 Fund to the Department of Insurance for grants and expenses
 17 related to or in support of the George Bailey Memorial Program.

18 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
 19 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
 20 hereinafter named, are appropriated from the Public Pension
 21 Regulation Fund to the Department of Insurance:

13 Section 40. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may
 14 be necessary, is appropriated from the Public Pension
 15 Regulation Fund to the Department of Insurance for costs and
 16 expenses related to or in support of the agency's operations.

17 Section 45. The sum of \$950,000, or so much thereof as may
 18 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers'
 19 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the Department of
 20 Insurance for costs associated with the administration and
 21 operations of the Insurance Fraud Division of the Illinois
 22 Workers' Compensation Commission's Anti-Fraud Program.

1 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
2 1, 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General
3 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
4 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
