The amount of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof 21 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Veterans 22 Assistance Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for 1 making grants, funding additional services, or conducting 2 additional research projects relating to veterans' post traumatic stress disorder; veterans' homelessness; the health 3 insurance cost of veterans; veterans' disability benefits, 4 including but not limited to, disability benefits provided by 5 6 veterans service organizations and veterans assistance commissions or centers; and the long-term care of veterans. 7

8 Section 25. The following named amount, or so much thereof 9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois 10 Affordable Housing Trust Fund to the Department of Veterans' 11 Affairs for the object and purpose and in the amount set forth 12 as follows:
