## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/8-3-20 new

Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that on and after the effective date of this amendatory Act, a home rule unit may not impose any tax increase or levy any new or additional tax without prior referendum approval. Limits home rule powers.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by adding

  Section 8-3-20 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/8-3-20 new)
- Sec. 8-3-20. Home rule taxing authority; referendum.

  Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, on and
  after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 100th
  General Assembly, a home rule unit may not impose any tax
  increase or levy any new or additional tax without prior
  referendum approval. This Section is a denial and limitation of
  home rule powers and functions under subsection (g) of Section

6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution.
