## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 57/5 625 ILCS 57/6 new

Amends the Transportation Network Providers Act. Provides that the Illinois Commerce Commission may request documentation or investigate business practices by a transportation network company to determine compliance with the Act. Provides that failure to comply with any provision of the Act, as determined by the Commission, shall subject a transportation network company to penalties imposed by the Commission. Effective July 1, 2018.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Transportation Network Providers Act is amended by changing Section 5 and by adding Section 6 as follows:

- 8 (Section scheduled to be repealed on June 1, 2020)
- 9 Sec. 5. Definitions.
- 10 "Commission" means the Illinois Commerce Commission.
  - "Transportation network company" or "TNC" means an entity operating in this State that uses a digital network or software application service to connect passengers to transportation network company services provided by transportation network company drivers. A TNC is not deemed to own, control, operate, or manage the vehicles used by TNC drivers, and is not a taxicab association or a for-hire vehicle owner.
- "Transportation network company driver" or "TNC driver"

  means an individual who operates a motor vehicle that is:
- 20 (1) owned, leased, or otherwise authorized for use by the individual;
- 22 (2) not a taxicab or for-hire public passenger vehicle;

1 (3) used to provide transportation network company 2 services.

"Transportation network company services" or "TNC services" means transportation of a passenger between points chosen by the passenger and prearranged with a TNC driver through the use of a TNC digital network or software application. TNC services shall begin when a TNC driver accepts a request for transportation received through the TNC's digital network or software application service, continue while the TNC driver transports the passenger in the TNC driver's vehicle, and end when the passenger exits the TNC driver's vehicle. TNC service is not a taxicab, for-hire vehicle, or street hail service.

- 16 Sec. 6. Authority of the Commission. The Commission may request documentation or investigate business practices by a 17 18 transportation network company to determine compliance with this Act. Failure to comply with any Section of this Act, as 19 20 determined by the Commission, shall subject a transportation 21 network company to penalties imposed by the Commission.
- 22 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 23 2018.
