#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 415/12g new  
105 ILCS 5/13-43.17

from Ch. 122, par. 13-43.17

Amends the Personnel Code. Provides that the Department of Central Management Services is not required to verify the State educator license of a teacher employed by the Department of Juvenile Justice if the license is verified by the State Board of Education. Provides that the provision shall become inoperative when the consent decree entered into on December 6, 2012 (as has been or may be corrected, amended, or modified in the action entitled R.J., et al. v. Mueller, case no. 12-cv-07289, in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division) is no longer in force. Amends the Department of Juvenile Justice School District Article of the School Code. Provides that the salary of a teacher employed by the Department of Juvenile Justice shall be comparable to the salary of a teacher employed by a school district in the same geographical area in which the institution or facility is located. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Personnel Code is amended by adding Section  
5 12g as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 415/12g new)

7 Sec. 12g. Department of Juvenile Justice; teachers.

8 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the  
9 contrary, the Department of Central Management Services is not  
10 required to verify the State educator license of a teacher  
11 employed by the Department of Juvenile Justice if the license  
12 is verified by the State Board of Education.

13 (b) This Section shall become inoperative when the consent  
14 decree entered into on December 6, 2012 (as has been or may be  
15 corrected, amended, or modified in the action entitled R.J., et  
16 al. v. Mueller, case no. 12-cv-07289, in the United States  
17 District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern  
18 Division) is no longer in force.

19 Section 10. The School Code is amended by changing Section  
20 13-43.17 as follows:

21 (105 ILCS 5/13-43.17) (from Ch. 122, par. 13-43.17)

1           Sec. 13-43.17. To employ teacher personnel in accordance  
2 with the Personnel Code, of the State of Illinois, including  
3 Provisional Appointments, and such teacher personnel will be  
4 subject to Article 16 of the "Illinois Pension Code" and shall  
5 not be subject to Article 14 of that Code; and shall be subject  
6 to the "Personnel Code." The Board may also utilize personnel  
7 as set forth in Section 10-22.34 of this Act as well as  
8 vocational and occupational instructors. The salary of a  
9 teacher employed by the Department of Juvenile Justice shall be  
10 comparable to the salary of a teacher employed by a school  
11 district in the same geographical area in which the institution  
12 or facility is located.
