SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 1705/7.2a new

Amends the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Administrative Act. Provides that as the Department of Human Services establishes reimbursement rates that build toward livable wages for front-line personnel in programs serving persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities, the Department shall include rates for therapeutic schools and other programs serving children with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Defines "front-line personnel". Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning State government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental
Disabilities Administrative Act is amended by adding Section
7.2a as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 1705/7.2a new)

8 Sec. 7.2a. Increased wages for front-line personnel 9 serving children. As the Department establishes reimbursement rates that build toward livable wages for front-line personnel 10 11 in programs serving persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities, the Department shall include rates 12 for therapeutic schools and other programs serving children 13 14 with intellectual and developmental disabilities. As used in this Section, "front-line personnel" means direct support 15 16 persons, aides, front-line supervisors, qualified intellectual 17 disabilities professionals, educators, nurses, and non-administrative support staff working in service settings 18 19 outlined in this Section.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 21 becoming law.
