225 ILCS 150/5

Amends the Telehealth Act. Includes clinicians licensed to provide medical services under Illinois law in the definition of "health care professional".

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AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Telehealth Act is amended by changing
Section 5 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 150/5)

7 Sec. 5. Definitions. As used in this Act:

"Health care professional" includes physicians, physician 8 9 assistants, optometrists, advanced practice nurses, clinical licensed in Illinois, and mental 10 psychologists health professionals and clinicians authorized by Illinois law to 11 provide mental health services, and any clinician licensed to 12 provide medical services under Illinois law. 13

14 "Telehealth" the evaluation, means diagnosis, or interpretation of electronically transmitted patient-specific 15 16 data between a remote location and a licensed health care 17 professional that generates interaction or treatment recommendations. "Telehealth" includes telemedicine and the 18 19 delivery of health care services provided by way of an 20 interactive telecommunications system, defined as in subsection (a) of Section 356z.22 of the Illinois Insurance 21 22 Code.
