## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Telehealth Act is amended by changing

- 7 Sec. 5. Definitions. As used in this Act:
- 8 "Health care professional" includes physicians, physician
- 9 assistants, optometrists, advanced practice registered nurses,
- 10 clinical psychologists licensed in Illinois, dentists,
- 11 <u>occupational therapists</u>, pharmacists, physical therapists,
- 12 clinical social workers, speech-language pathologists,
- 13 audiologists, hearing instrument dispensers, and mental health
- 14 professionals and clinicians authorized by Illinois law to
- 15 provide mental health services.
- 16 "Telehealth" means the evaluation, diagnosis, or
- interpretation of electronically transmitted patient-specific
- 18 data between a remote location and a licensed health care
- 19 professional that generates interaction or treatment
- 20 recommendations. "Telehealth" includes telemedicine and the
- 21 delivery of health care services provided by way of an
- 22 interactive telecommunications system, as defined in
- 23 subsection (a) of Section 356z.22 of the Illinois Insurance
