8	(a) In this Section, "med	lia literacy" means the ability to
9	access, analyze, evaluate,	create, and communicate using a
10	variety of forms, including,	out not limited to, print, visual,
11	audio, interactive, and digit	al texts.
12	(b) Beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, every public	
13	high school may include in its curriculum a unit of instruction	
14	on media literacy. The unit of instruction shall include, but	
15	is not limited to, analyzing:	

(1) the purpose of media messages and how they are

2	(2) explicit and implicit media messages;	
3	(3) values and points of view that are included and	
4	<pre>excluded in the media;</pre>	
5	(4) how the media may influence ideas and behaviors;	
6	<u>and</u>	
7	(5) the importance of obtaining information from	
8	multiple media sources.	
9	(c) The State Superintendent of Education may prepare and	
10	make available to school boards instructional materials tha	
11	may be used as guidelines for development of a unit of	
12	instruction under this Section.	
13	Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upor	
14	becoming law.".
