

1 AN ACT concerning government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Intergovernmental Cooperation Act is  
5 amended by changing Section 4.5 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 220/4.5)

7 Sec. 4.5. Prohibited agreements and contracts. No  
8 intergovernmental or interagency agreement or contract may be  
9 entered into, implemented, or given effect if the agreement's  
10 or contract's intent or effect is: (i) to circumvent any  
11 limitation established by law on State appropriation or State  
12 expenditure authority with respect to health care and employee  
13 benefits contracts; ~~or~~ (ii) to expend State moneys in a manner  
14 inconsistent with the purpose for which they were appropriated  
15 with respect to health care and employee benefits contracts;  
16 (iii) to circumvent any limitation established by law  
17 pertaining to payroll certification under Section 9.03 of the  
18 State Finance Act; or (iv) for appropriations for the Office of  
19 the Governor enacted after the effective date of this  
20 amendatory Act of the 100th General Assembly, to authorize the  
21 payment of employees of the Office of the Governor out of  
22 appropriations other than those established for that purpose.

1 Section 10. The State Finance Act is amended by changing  
2 Section 9.03 as follows:

3 (30 ILCS 105/9.03) (from Ch. 127, par. 145d)

4 Sec. 9.03. The certification on every State payroll voucher  
5 shall be as follows:

6 "I certify that the employees named, their respective  
7 indicated positions and service times, and appropriation to be  
8 charged, as shown on the accompanying payroll sheets are true,  
9 complete, correct and according to the provisions of law; that  
10 such employees are involved in decision making or have direct  
11 line responsibility to a person who has decision making  
12 authority concerning the objectives, functions, goals and  
13 policies of the organizational unit for which the appropriation  
14 was made; that the results of the work performed by these  
15 employees and that substantially all of their working time is  
16 directly related to the objectives, functions, goals, and  
17 policies of the organizational unit for which the appropriation  
18 is made; that all working time was expended in the service of  
19 the State; and that the employees named are entitled to payment  
20 in the amounts indicated. If applicable, the reporting  
21 requirements of Section 5.1 of the Governor's Office of  
22 Management and Budget Act have been met.

1           For departments under the Civil Administrative Code, the  
2           foregoing certification shall be executed by the Chief  
3           Executive Officer of the department from whose appropriation  
4           the payment will be made or his designee, in addition to any  
5           other certifications or approvals which may be required by law.

6           The foregoing certification shall not be required for  
7           expenditures from amounts appropriated to the Comptroller for  
8           payment of the salaries of State officers.

9           For appropriations for the Office of the Governor enacted  
10          after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 100th  
11          General Assembly, (1) the foregoing certification shall be  
12          required for expenditures from amounts appropriated to the  
13          Office of the Governor for payment of salaries of Governor's  
14          Office employees and executed by the Governor, or his or her  
15          designee, in addition to any other certifications or approvals  
16          which may be required by law to be made; and (2) in no event  
17          shall salaries of employees of the Office of the Governor be  
18          paid from appropriations other than those established for that  
19          purpose.
