2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 5231, AS AMENDED, by  
3 replacing everything after the enacting clause with the  
4 following:

5 "Section 5. The Uniform Peace Officers' Disciplinary Act is  
6 amended by changing Section 6 and adding Section 7.2 as  
7 follows:

8 (50 ILCS 725/6) (from Ch. 85, par. 2567)

9 Sec. 6. Except as otherwise provided in this Act, the ~~The~~  
10 provisions of this Act apply only to the extent there is no  
11 collective bargaining agreement currently in effect dealing  
12 with the subject matter of this Act.

15 Sec. 7.2. Possession of a Firearm Owner's Identification

1 Card. An employer of an officer shall not make possession of a  
2 Firearm Owner's Identification Card a condition of continued  
3 employment if the officer's Firearm Owner's Identification  
4 Card is revoked or seized because the officer has been a  
5 patient of a mental health facility and the officer has not  
6 been determined to pose a clear and present danger to himself,  
7 herself, or others as determined by a physician, clinical  
8 psychologist, or qualified examiner. Nothing in this Section  
9 shall otherwise impair an employer's ability to determine an  
10 officer's fitness for duty. On and after the effective date of  
11 this amendatory Act of the 100th General Assembly, Section 6 of  
12 this Act shall not apply to the prohibition requiring a Firearm  
13 Owner's Identification Card as a condition of continued  
14 employment, but a collective bargaining agreement already in  
15 effect on that issue on the effective date of this amendatory  
16 Act of the 100th General Assembly cannot be modified.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
18 becoming law."
