SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$10,000,000 to the Illinois State Board of Education for after-school art programs and \$10,000,000 to the Illinois Arts Council for community art programs. Effective July 1, 2018.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
6 to the Illinois State Board of Education to provide grants for
7 after-school, art-based programs for schools with a low-income
8 pupil count greater than 70% as certified by the Department of
9 Human Services.

10 Section 10. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
12 to the Illinois Arts Council for community art programs located
13 in a census tract that is 125% below the poverty level according
14 to the United States Census Bureau to administer arts education
15 and art therapy programs.

16 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
17 2018.
