A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. In addition to other amounts appropriated, the
6 amount of \$1,948,500, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
7 is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois
8 Emergency Management Agency for operational expenses, awards,
9 grants, administrative expenses, including refunds, and
10 permanent improvements.

11 Section 7. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
13 Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for deposit
14 into the Disaster Response and Recovery Fund.

15 Section 10. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
16 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois Emergency
17 Management Agency for the objects and purposes hereinafter
18 named:

11 Section 20. The sum of \$75,500, or so much thereof as may
12 be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety Emergency
13 Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
14 for the ordinary and contingent expenses incurred by the
15 Illinois Emergency Management Agency.

16 Section 25. The sum of \$12,000,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Disaster Response
18 and Recovery Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
19 for all current and prior year expenses associated with
20 disaster response and recovery.

21 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much thereof

6 Section 45. The sum of \$275,000, or so much thereof as may
 7 be necessary, is appropriated from the Sheffield February 1982
 8 Agreed Order Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
 9 for the care, maintenance, monitoring, testing, remediation and
 10 insurance of the low-level radioactive waste disposal site near
 11 Sheffield, Illinois.

12 Section 50. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
 13 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the

22 Section 60. The amount of \$23,010,400, or so much thereof
23 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Homeland Security
24 Emergency Preparedness Trust Fund to the Illinois Emergency

1 Management Agency for current and prior year expenses related
2 to the federally funded Emergency Preparedness Grant Program.

3 Section 63. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
5 to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for all costs
6 associated with homeland security and emergency preparedness
7 and response, including grants and operational expenses.

8 Section 65. The sum of \$240,000, or so much thereof as may
9 be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety Emergency
10 Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
11 for ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Emergency
12 Management Agency to include support of a centralized
13 administrative processing center.

14 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
15 1, 2018. Notwithstanding anything in this Act to the contrary,
16 appropriations authorized in this Act shall be used for all
17 costs incurred prior to July 1, 2019.
