## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

Section 3. The sum of \$593,392,900, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for ordinary and contingent expenses of the department including Permanent Improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019.

Section 5.
