AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented 2 in the General Assembly: 3

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ARTICLE 1

Section 1. The amount of \$4,797,900, or so much thereof 5 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Power 7 Agency from the Illinois Power Agency Operations Fund for its 8 ordinary and contingent expenses.

Section 5. The amount of \$1,125,200, or so much thereof 9 10 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois as Power Agency from the Illinois Power Agency Trust Fund for 11 12 deposit into the Illinois Power Agency Operations Fund 13 pursuant to subsection (c) of Section 6z-75 of the State 14 Finance Act.

Section 10. The amount of \$50,000,000, or so much thereof 15 16 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Power 17 Agency from the Illinois Power Agency Renewable Energy 18 Resources Fund for funding of current and prior fiscal year 19 purchases of renewable energy resources and related expenses, 20 including the refund of bidder deposit fees overpayments of

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HB5420 -2- OMB100 00201 MAL 10201 b alternative compliance payments, and expenses related to the development and administration of the Illinois Solar for All Program, pursuant to subsections (b), (c), and (i) of Section 1-56 of the Illinois Power Agency Act.

5 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1, 6 2018. Notwithstanding anything in this Act to the contrary, 7 appropriations authorized in this Act shall be used for all 8 costs incurred prior to July 1, 2019.
