1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Administrative Act is amended by changing Section
- 6 53 as follows:

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- 7 (20 ILCS 1705/53) (from Ch. 91 1/2, par. 100-53)
- 8 Sec. 53. The Department shall create a consistent case 9 coordination system for persons with a developmental disability who receive services provided or funded by the 10 Department. The objectives of this system shall be to ensure 11 that a full range of an individual's needs is identified and 12 assessed through statewide use of an individual client 13 14 assessment tool; to ensure that each individual actually receives, in the most effective and efficient combination and 15 16 sequence, the full range and continuum of services needed; to 17 ensure that all available resources are applied appropriately to each individual served; and to provide a systematic 18 19 procedure for serving individuals which generates among and local service delivery agencies information 20 within the 21 required for effective system management.
 - Specific to the individual client assessment tool, each individual living in a community integrated living arrangement

1 shall receive an annual client assessment. The annual client 2 assessment shall be completed using the Health Risk Screening Tool. Beginning January 1, 2019, each individual shall receive 3 his or her annual client assessment via the web-based Health 4 5 Risk Screening Tool. The Health Risk Screening Tool shall replace the current paper-based version of the assessment. The 6 Department shall make changes to the Illinois Administrative 7

Code to correspond with this online version of the Health Risk

- 10 "Case coordination" means a mechanism for linking and 11 coordinating segments of the service delivery system to ensure 12 the most comprehensive program for meeting an individual 13 client's needs. It facilitates client movement through an array of services so that at any given time, services received are 14 matched to the needs of the individual. 15
