2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 5544 as follows:
3	on page 2, by replacing lines 19 and 20 with the following:
4	"(11) wide racial and ethnic disparities exist in
5	Illinois pregnancy-related mortality rates, which in 2013,
6	in deaths per 100,000 births, were 8.1 for Caucasian women
7	and 28.9 for African American women, and the severe
8	maternal morbidity rate for Illinois between 2011-2013 was
9	higher than the national rate;
10	(12) teen pregnancy is often unintended and can have
11	long-term negative health effects on future physical,
12	behavioral, educational, and economic development of
13	mothers and children, and teen birth rates in Illinois are
14	significantly higher for African American and Hispanic
15	teens than for Caucasian teens;

- 7 ""Woman" or "women" means all persons of the female gender, 8 including both cisgender and transgender persons.
- 9 "Transgender" describes persons whose gender identity is 10 different from the gender they were assigned at birth.
- "Cisgender" describes persons whose gender identity is the same as the gender they were assigned at birth.
- "Gender identity" means a person's deeply felt, inherent sense of who they are as a particular gender, such as female.";

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- on page 4, by replacing lines 5 through 10 with the following:
- 17 "(7) to promote increased access to reproductive 18 health care;
 - (8) to protect women who are transgender from violence and harassment, and increase their fair and equal access to culturally competent health care, housing, employment, and other opportunities;
