SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 66/60

Amends the Firearms Concealed Carry Act. Provides that for a new or renewal concealed carry license, the fee shall be \$75 (rather than \$150), of which \$60 (rather than \$120) shall be apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$5 (rather than \$20) shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund. Provides that a non-resident applicant for a new license or renewal shall submit \$150 (rather than \$300) and a licensee requesting a new license shall submit \$10 (rather than \$75). Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Firearm Concealed Carry Act is amended by changing Section 60 as follows:
- 6 (430 ILCS 66/60)
- 7 Sec. 60. Fees.
- 8 (a) All fees collected under this Act shall be deposited as 9 provided in this Section. Application, renewal, and
- 10 replacement fees shall be non-refundable.
- 11 (b) An applicant for a new license or a renewal shall 12 submit \$75 \frac{\$150}{} with the application, of which \$60 \frac{\$120}{} shall
- 13 be apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$5
- 14 \$20 shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund,
- and \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory
- 16 Fund.
- 17 (c) A non-resident applicant for a new license or renewal
- shall submit $\frac{$150}{}$ \$\frac{\$300}{}\$ with the application, of which $\frac{$100}{}$ \$\frac{\$250}{}\$
- shall be apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund,
- \$40 shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund,
- 21 and \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory
- 22 Fund.
- 23 (d) A licensee requesting a new license in accordance with

- 1 Section 55 shall submit $\frac{$10}{}$ $\frac{$75}{}$, of which $\frac{$5}{}$ $\frac{$60}{}$ shall be
- 2 apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$5 shall
- 3 be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$5 \$10
- 4 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.
