SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$7,940,486 from the Illinois Habitat Fund to the Department of Natural Resources for the preservation and maintenance of high quality habitat lands in accordance with the provisions of the Habitat Endowment Act. Appropriates \$2,718,401 from the Illinois Habitat Fund to the Department of Natural Resources for the preservation and maintenance of a high quality fish and wildlife habitat and to promote the heritage of outdoor sports in Illinois from revenue derived from the sale of Sportsmen Series license plates. Effective July 1, 2018.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$7,940,486, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Habitat Fund
6 to the Department of Natural Resources for the preservation and
7 maintenance of high quality habitat lands in accordance with
8 the provisions of the "Habitat Endowment Act", as now or
9 hereafter amended.

10 Section 10. The sum of \$2,718,401, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Habitat
12 Fund to the Department of Natural Resources for the
13 preservation and maintenance of a high quality fish and
14 wildlife habitat and to promote the heritage of outdoor sports
15 in Illinois from revenue derived from the sale of Sportsmen
16 Series license plates.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
18 2018.
