- (4) one appointed by an Illinois business group; 15

- (6) 20 appointed by the AFL-CIO; and 17

- 1 Illinois House of Representatives; and be it further
- 2 RESOLVED, That the Illinois Department of Commerce and
- 3 Economic Opportunity Office of Trade and Investment shall
- 4 provide administrative support for the International Job
- 5 Protection Task Force and shall reimburse for their reasonable
- 6 and prudent expenses; and be it further
- 7 RESOLVED, That the International Job Protection Task Force
- 8 shall provide a final report by December 31, 2017.
