1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE RESOLUTION 114 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Resolution 114 by replacing everything after the heading with the following: 3 "WHEREAS, President Donald Trump is taking steps to fulfill 4 5 his campaign promise to build a wall along the border between 6 the United States and Mexico; and 7 WHEREAS, President Trump has suggested that a tariff of 20% should be placed on products imported from Mexico to pay for 8 the border wall, which would essentially result in Americans 9 paying for the wall; he has also suggested a 20% tariff on 10 11 imports of Canadian lumber; and 12 WHEREAS, Mexico is the second-largest export partner of Illinois and the third-largest import partner; Canada is the 13

largest export and import partner;

- 1 WHEREAS, The North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) is
- a free trade agreement between the United States, Mexico, and 2
- 3 Canada, which creates a trilateral trade bloc in North America;
- 4 and
- 5 WHEREAS, President Trump claims that he received calls in
- April of 2017 from the President of Mexico and the Prime 6
- 7 Minister of Canada asking to renegotiate NAFTA rather than
- 8 terminate it, to which he agreed; therefore, be it
- 9 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE
- HUNDREDTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we 10
- 11 formally invite Mexican President Enrique Pena Nieto to address
- 12 a joint session of the Illinois General Assembly to discuss the
- 13 proposed border wall, the impact of a 20% tariff on goods
- 14 imported from Mexico to pay for the wall, the economic impact
- of the wall, and the impact that President Trump's policies 15
- will have on Illinois and Mexico; and be it further 16
- 17 RESOLVED, That we invite Canadian Prime Minister Justin
- Trudeau to discuss trade issues between Canada and Illinois; 18
- 19 and be it further
- 20 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- 21 delivered to Enrique Pena Nieto, President of Mexico, and
- 22 Justin Trudeau, Prime Minister of Canada."
