15 Merit; he retired in 2004, but remained active with the
16 organization; in retirement, he began working part-time at the
17 Dieterle Memorial Home, where he greeted many guests through
18 the years and offered much comfort to grieving families; and

20 Community Church, serving in many capacities; he was also a
21 member of Batavia Moose Lodge #682 and the Aurora Rotary Club;
