1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The rise of gun violence in the City of Chicago 3 has begun to spread to Chicago-area expressways at an 4 ever-increasing rate; and

5 WHEREAS, As of the end of 2016, there were 51 shootings on 6 Chicago-area expressways, compared to 37 in 2015; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bruce Rauner has proposed that the State add hundreds of new Illinois State Police to combat the growing number of shooting incidents on Chicago-area expressways; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago Crime Commission has requested that State and federal officials purchase a high-tech expressway video surveillance system, which would assist law enforcement in identifying and apprehending those responsible for the expressway gun violence; and

WHEREAS, The area just south of Interstate 290 is popularly referred to as the "Heroin Highway" because of the easy access to the drug it offers city and suburban residents; the heroin epidemic within the City of Chicago is believed to be fueling much of the gun-related violence that is now spilling onto Chicago-area expressways; therefore, be it

- RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE
  HUNDREDTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we
  urge Governor Rauner to use discretionary funds to install the
  high-tech expressway video surveillance system recommended by
  the Chicago Crime Commission as soon as possible; and be it
