1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Millions of households in Illinois subscribe to services that provide audio and video entertainment, whether through a wire-based cable or through a satellite dish; this includes audio streaming, video streaming, and many other services; and

- WHEREAS, One proposal for increasing Illinois tax revenue include the levying of a 6.25% State sales tax on media services that includes audio and video streaming; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Illinois should not increase taxes on citizens who
 11 depend on cable TV and satellite services for news and
 12 entertainment; these news programs are vital to a well-informed
 13 populace; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE
 HUNDREDTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we
 oppose expanding the State sales tax to cover the delivery of
 audio and video services, by cable TV, satellite dish, or other
 infrastructure, to Illinois homes and households; and be it
