HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of
3 Representatives are pleased to congratulate Raymond J. Rose on
4 his retirement as Lake County Undersheriff, bringing a 50-year
5 law enforcement career to a close; and

6 WHEREAS, Raymond Rose became undersheriff in 2013; he
7 previously served as chief of police for the Village of
8 Mundelein since 1992; prior to assuming the position of chief
9 with Mundelein, he served with the Elk Grove Village Police
10 Department for 24 years, achieving the rank of deputy chief;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, Raymond Rose has had extensive training and
13 education focused on law enforcement, including the 59th
14 nine-month Police Administration Training Program class at
15 Northwestern University's Center for Public Safety, the 161st
16 Session of the National F.B.I. Academy at Quantico, Virginia,
17 the 15th Session of the Senior Management Institute for Police
18 hosted by the Police Executive Research Forum and Harvard's
19 Kennedy School of Government, the Northwestern Executive
20 Management Program, the FBI Midwest Law Enforcement Executive
21 Development Program, and the FBI LEEDS course at Quantico; he
22 received his bachelor's degree in Liberal Arts and Sciences
23 from Northern Illinois University and a master's degree in

1 public administration from Northern Illinois University, and
2 was inducted into the Pi Alpha Alpha National Honors Society
3 for Public Affairs Administration; and

4 WHEREAS, Raymond Rose has been active in many groups
5 serving the law enforcement community, including being past
6 president of the Illinois Association of Chiefs of Police, past
7 president of the Lake County Chiefs of Police Association, past
8 president of the Board of Directors-Northern Illinois Crime
9 Lab, past president of the Northeast Multi-Regional Training
10 Board, chairman of the Lake County Major Crime Task Force,
11 chairman of the Lake County Metropolitan Enforcement Group,
12 secretary of the Northern Illinois Police Alarm System Board,
13 and numerous other law enforcement affiliated organizations;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, Raymond Rose has had articles published in several
16 law enforcement magazines, including Police Chief Magazine,
17 Command Magazine, and Law Enforcement Technology Magazine; he
18 co-authored a graduate-level textbook on public
19 administration, Managing Local Government; and

20 WHEREAS, Raymond Rose has received many honors during his
21 storied law enforcement career, including the Focus on Youth
22 Award from the Chicago Police Department and the Illinois
23 Association of Chiefs of Police, the Law Enforcement Award from

1 the Lake County Juvenile Officers Association, the Commitment
2 to Community's Children Award from District 75, the SHOCAP
3 Service Award, the Public Safety Executive Leadership Award
4 from the Northwestern University Center for Public Safety, the
5 Community Leadership Award from NICASA, the GLMV Community
6 Service Award, the Community Service Award from the Illinois
7 Park and Recreation Association, the Ruth H. Rosengarden Victim
8 Service Provider Award by LCSA Michael Waller, and the NICASA
9 Angel Ball Honoree; therefore, be it
