WHEREAS, When the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, 2 3 D.C. was finished in 1983, the wall listed more than 58,000 4 servicemen and women who had either died in action or went missing during the Vietnam War; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Due to a fire at government storage facility in 7 1973, the United States military lost millions of personnel 8 records, including many of those who were listed on the wall; 9 and 10 WHEREAS, The military and other organizations made efforts to recover the lost data; 24,000 veterans listed on the wall 11 12 still had no picture in military records as of 2013; and

WHEREAS, In January of 2017, the Illinois Press Association

communities to locate 100 of the missing photos; 45 counties in

Illinois are home to the remaining 479 soldiers without photos;
