1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, President Barack Obama concluded his second and 2 3 final term as President of the United States of America on 4 January 20, 2017, and has announced plans to build a presidential library and museum in Chicago; and 5 6 WHEREAS, A recent legislative initiative proposes to 7 allocate \$100 million from Illinois capital spending funds for 8 the construction of President Obama's Presidential Library and 9 Museum; and 10 WHEREAS, This proposal comes at a time when the State's 11 budget condition continues to worsen and economic growth 12 continues to lag behind national recovery trends; and 13 WHEREAS, The State of Illinois has a \$15 billion backlog of 14 unpaid bills; over the last five years, the State has been 15 unable to adequately fund budget priorities, such as education, 16 human services, and public safety programs and services; and 17 WHEREAS, The last two Presidents of the United States have 18 used private donations to build their libraries; and 19 WHEREAS, No presidential libraries overseen by the

National Archives and Records Administration have received

- direct funding from either the federal government or their
