1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Lost deliveries negatively affect businesses,

3 hurt residents, communities, and the economy; and

- WHEREAS, Service standards implemented by mail package delivery services are essential to providing prompt and timely delivery of all mail, including online purchases; with more Americans shopping online, the number of package thefts have been increasing; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Each year more than 23 million Americans have 10 their packages stolen and lose an average of \$140.00; and
- 11 WHEREAS, According to Consumer Affairs, more than 4,000 12 customers have filed complaints against shipping companies 13 regarding the theft of packages; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Citizens prevent package theft can by implementing additional safety precautions, including using 15 Smart Package Lockers or convenience stores to secure packages, 16 17 having packages delivered to a workplace, installing front door 18 security cameras, requiring a signature on delivery, rerouting or rescheduling package deliveries, requiring vacation package 19 20 holds, purchasing a package guard, and insuring packages; 21 therefore, be it

- 1 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE
 2 HUNDREDTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we
 3 urge package delivery companies to respond to the increased
 4 public concern by examining ways to reduce package thefts and
- 5 expedite customer refunds as appropriate; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That we urge the citizens of Illinois to take
 additional measures to make sure their packages are not stolen
 from their front doors or porches; and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be 10 presented to the United States Postal Service, Amazon, FedEx, 11 and UPS.
